

K79260 Watercolor Medium

Gum arabic is the most important thing in watercolor painting - but then it gets complicated.

For centuries, watercolor manufacturers have been trying to improve the paintability of watercolor. For processing pigments as watercolor, you can easily make an excellent watercolor with Kremer watercolor painting medium.

You can paint most pigments directly with this medium and a brush.

Kremer Watercolor Stain contains gum arabic with honey and glycerin as plasticizers for best durability.

Recommendation for use:

- Take a few drops of watercolor painting medium (K79260) and some distilled water to 1 3 teaspoons of dry pigment.
- Add a few drops of ox gall (K78087) to improve fluidity.
- Rub with a runner to a homogeneous paste and pour into watercolor cups let them cure overnight. Leave to harden overnight.

The easiest pigments to work with are:

- Cadmium, cobalt and ultramarine pigments, iron oxides and earth colors.
